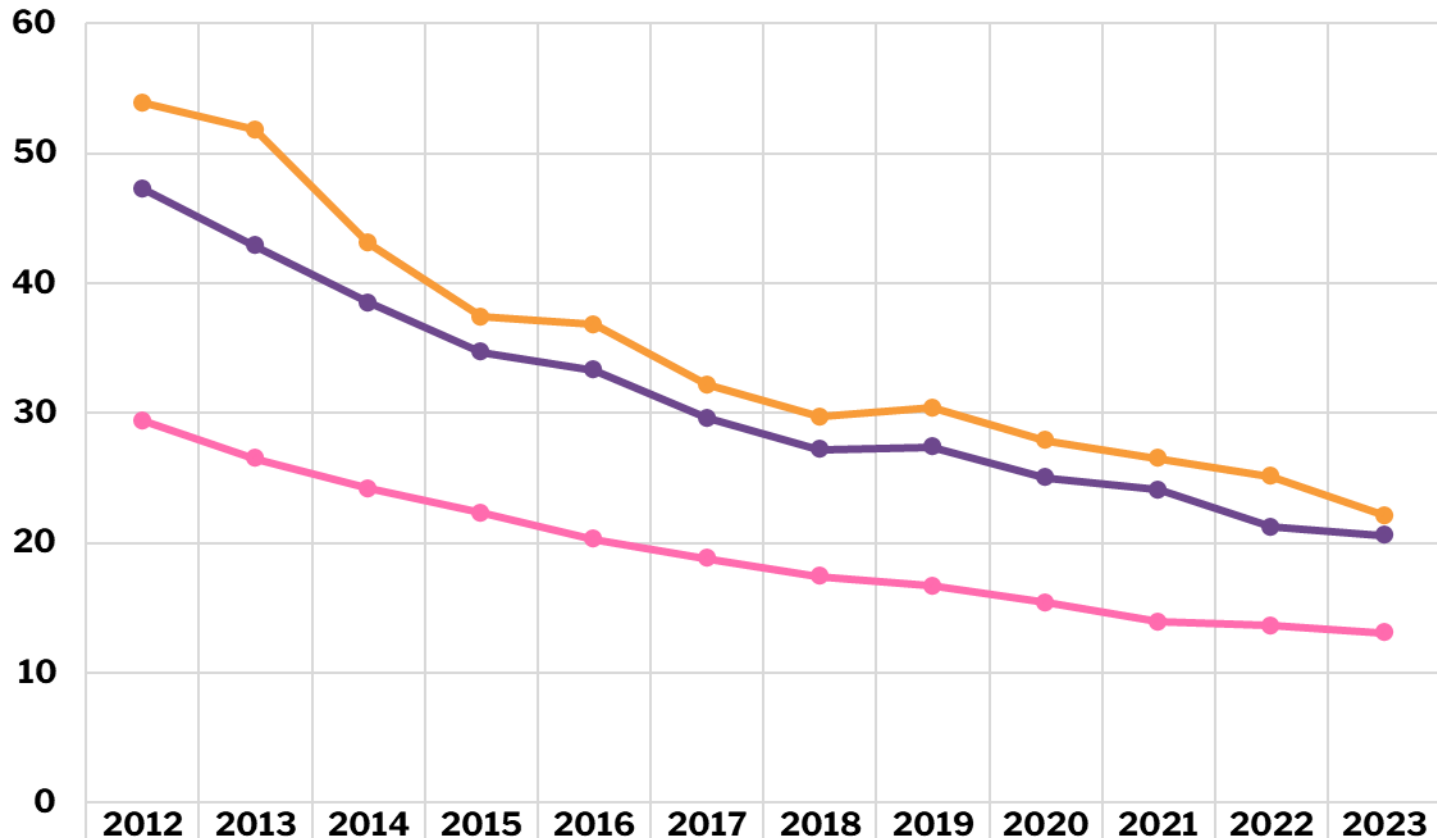
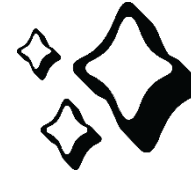




TEEN BIRTH RATE
